It is difficult to climb back to Shutesbury road through the thicket.


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-We need to refresh the red paint!!

- B. Inside corner of building envelope) 42.44473080, -72.48666652 2, orange rebar
- C. SE corner of CR (behind house, on line) 42.44404399, -72.48651540, orange rebar
- D. SW corner of CR (abutting G.King) 42.44382782, -72.48917607, iron pipe by tree trunk
- E. NW corner of CR (east of covered bridge) 42.44453349, -72.48926609, iron pipe
- F. Along stream, 42.44450734, -72.48771535 (not found, ribbon on tree no longer obvious)
- G. NE corner of CR (road, at stream) 42.44555927, -72.48656552, culvert, bent metal (orange pipe n side of stream

Note: all found iron pipes have 3-dot orange paint on trees, Most lines painted orange (NO PAINT along roadside, streamside, or along stone wall section of s.side).
