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
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
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


Directions to David Smith Conservation Restriction

From Route 63, take Depot Road east 1 mile. Follow Depot Road as it turns left and then right for an additional 1/2 mile. (You will pass Leverett Pond on the left). At the fork in the road, bear right. You are now on Shutesbury Road. Follow Shutesbury Road 1.4 miles to the intersection with Cushman Road. Continue on Shutesbury Road (sharp right turn up hill). The Smith land is on the left at 0.4 miles from the turn. There is parking just beyond the power line (0.5 miles from the turn).
