The goal was to walk the borders of the East Leverett Meadow finding the corner posts in the process. I used the plot maps, topo/aerial maps with plot lines drawn in, compass and GPS. The aerial/topo were corrected after the visit.

Finding the "roadside woods" property lines were the most difficult - most of the other lines follow stone walls or fences. It was not possible to walk the full northern border - the beaver pond extends will back into the Adams land to the north of the ELM property.

Two household storage tanks were found at the tavern/foundation corner. These were later removed by Sheila Seaman. Other than that, there were no problems found on the property. (This property is visited regularly as part of the wildlife inventory.)
