

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,
That I Horatio Graves of Sunderland

in the County of Franklin and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Trader

in consideration of the sum of eighty four dollars, to me paid by James Fitts of Leverett

in the County of Franklin and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, aforesaid yeoman

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said James his heirs and assigns,

A certain Piece or tract of land situated in Leverett aforesaid bounded and described as follows viz. Beginning at the Southwest Corner at a stake & stones running Eastwardly joining land formerly owned by Enoch Brod about thirteen rods to a Stake & stones Then Northwardly about twenty rods Then Eastwardly about seven rods Then Northwardly about fifteen rods Then Eastwardly to Shutesbury line Then about twenty four rods on said line to the center of the Brook Then northwardly on the center of the Brook to Charles Stockwells land Then southwardly joining said Stockwells land to the first mentioned corner (excepting the highway on the above described land) containing twenty eight acres with the highway be it the same more or less it being the lot formerly owned by David Saunders

To have and to hold the afore-granted premises to the said James Fitts

his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever.
And I the said Horatio do hereby for myself and his executors and administrators covenant with the said James his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the afore-granted premises; That they are free of all incumbrances;

That I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said James

And that I and my heirs, executors and administrators, will warrant and defend the same premises to the said James his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
