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

However, using the existing GPS coordinates I was able to find each corner, all marked with flagging—this was very helpful in the absence of a view of the ground! It was easy to follow the border with the GPS coordinates and the map. I recalculated the GPS coordinates to fractions of a degree (from minutes), which is the easiest unit for use with my GPS. I have included the list of recalculated GPS coordinates.

Still need a photo of the Wenczel/CR corner near the powerline, on a leafless (and snowless) day.
In a few years, border paint/iron pin paint should be renewed.
