An appropriate long-range goal would be to negotiate public access all along Rat Hollow Road – it is already provided at the east end through RGT's David Smith CR. (Rat Hollow Road is open at the west end only as far as the Gordon King property. Legal access to Stetson Adams Memorial Woodland is through the Gordon King property.)


