<p>List observations, comments, management needs, information requests, areas needing discussion or review:</p> <p>The monitoring map did not have enough context and so has been changed to help folks find the property and property lines.</p> <p>Issue of the distances of the north and south lines is intellectually interesting, but not very important since the road forms the on-the-ground line on the east, and the land to the west is also owned by the town.</p> <p>An appropriate long-range goal would be to negotiate public access all along Rat Hollow Road – it is already provided at the east end through RGT’s David Smith CR. (Rat Hollow Road is open at the west end only as far as the Gordon King property. Legal access to Stetson Adams Memorial Woodland is through the Gordon King property.)</p>
