It is a lovely spot, especially the field of stones as you approach the NW corner (photo). Enjoy.



NE Corner: Cowls, Brushy Mt Rd, IP 42.4566, -72.4827 ip on west side of road SE Corner: Cowls, Downey, Brush Mt Rd, IP 42.4541, -72.4835 ip on east side of road

SW Corner: Downey, GKing Life Est, 42.4540, -72.4857 ip west of road NW Corner: on Cowls line, no IP, 42.4563, -72.4859 pile of stones

IP=iron (surveyor's) pipe

GKing East IP=42.450978,-72.488383; West IP 42.45084, -72.490103

Note: this map is for monitoring, it is not a legal description of the property.

Note on Gordon King iron pins along Rat Hollow Road.

The east pin is easy to find because the next property (Downey, Gordon's grandson) is well marked with flagging and no trespassing signs.

The west pin is just across from the balcony of the house on the other side of the road (George Drake's). It is set back and, although re-flagged, is difficult to see.
