

# Trail Information: Friendship Trail

## Directions:

Park in the pull-off area across the road from the boat launch. The trail entrance is just to the left/west of the boat launch and kiosk.



The Friendship Trail offers views of the birds and critters of the pond's edge. Look for the intriguing bark of the small, appropriately-named musclewood tree, *Carpinus caroliniana*. The pond itself can be explored on foot in winter or by kayak the rest of the year.

## Who takes care of these trails?

Three of the properties making up the Friendship Trail were purchased by the town with CPA funding. The Rattlesnake Gutter Trust holds the Conservation Restrictions. Trail work is done by neighbors and members of the Leverett Trails Committee, which is co-sponsored by the Leverett Conservation Commission and the Rattlesnake Gutter Trust.
