Walked up from Mary's house to the house at the top of the hill that has recently been sold; struggled to find pin and discussed how we could better mark it without making it visually disturbing. The walked to the southeast near the trail/boundary to the pin with Richardson Road neighbor (G6): no sign of use of trail by motorized vehicles as in the past. Walked the south edge of property; didn't go down to the road: viewed that by car. Walked out the lower trail and back up hill to area near Chris Carlisle, Mary's house and new neighbor; markings gone their and need reconfirming. The old hanging CD's on a string marking a bound are gone.

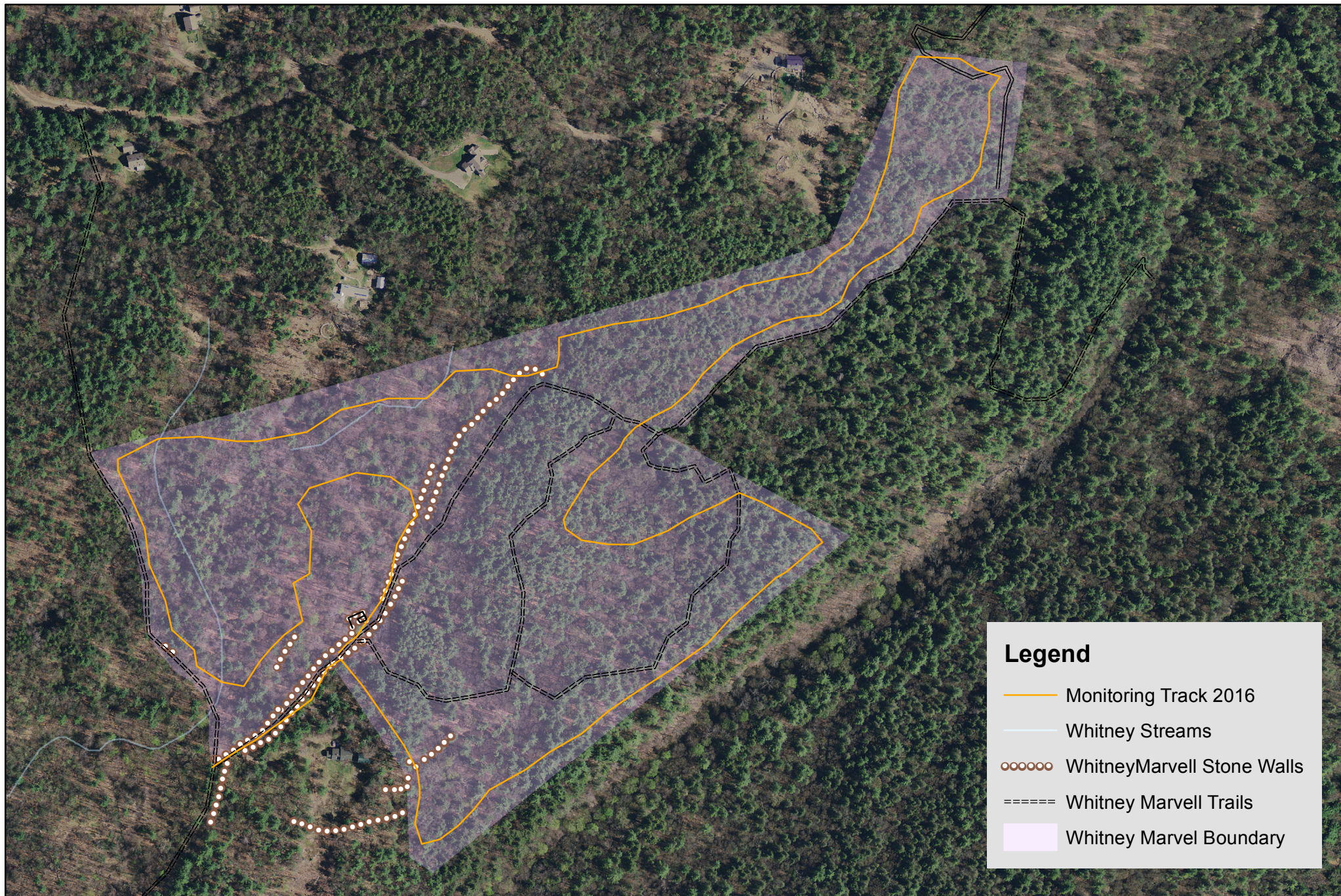
